**Notification of proposed upgrade to City of Gold Coast Maintenance and Operations Depot, Tugun**

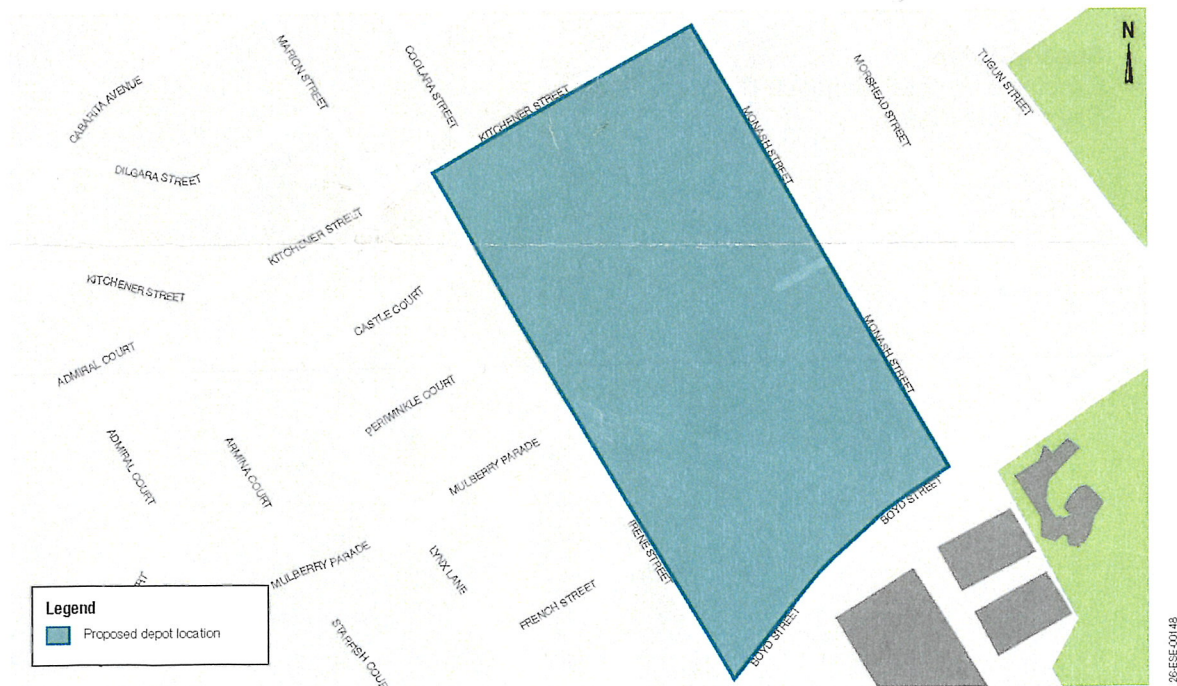
As part of the City of Gold Coast's commitment to enhancing the Gold Coast Way of Life, the City is undertaking works to upgrade the City's Tugun Depot at 2, 12, 22, 32 Irene Street, Tugun, and 24 Kitchener Street, Tugun (Lots 43 to 46 on Plan RP32012).

A review of the City's operations and accommodation indicated the opportunity to consolidate accommodation and redevelop City operational depots to provide more efficient services through the creation of regional super depots and satellite depots.

The purpose of these depots is to enable efficient and effective servicing and maintaining City-owned community assets. Due to the City's long, linear geography, numerous depots are distributed spatially to ensure ongoing service efficiency.

The City operates several existing depots that have been developed over the past decades. The review reassessed the key service areas within the city and improvements to existing depots where possible were proposed. The City, in consultation with the *Queensland Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning (DSDIP)*, has determined that a *Local Government Infrastructure Designation (LGID)*, made under the *Queensland Planning Act 2016* is an appropriate mechanism for enabling the staged redevelopment of these depots.
